## **Children/Youth Begin Meeting again**

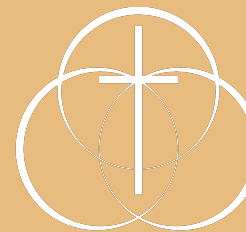
